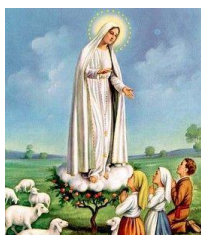

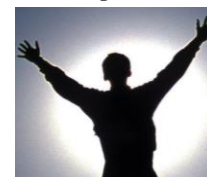


GROWING IN SELF CONFIDENCE
