### MEDITATION ON THE GOSPEL

When Jesus proclaimed the kingdom of God He met opposition and hostility. He tells His disciples that they must expect the same treatment if they are to live and to proclaim the reign of God. There is both a warning and a privilege in His statement. Just as Jesus had to carry His cross, so the disciples must carry their crosses and not try to evade it. To suffer for the faith is to share in the work of Christ. The Holy Spirit gives us power and grace to live as disciples of Jesus Christ.
