PARISH EDUCATION COMMITTEE (PEC) ELECTIONS

We are currently looking for 3 people to run for positions on the Committee. Two (2) of these positions are elected, one (1) position is Pastor appointed. This is a two (2) year commitment that involves and requires much time and dedication. If you are elected or appointed then you are eligible to earn 20 hours of credit for each year served and completed on the PEC, to be redeemed after your tenure is complete.

As per CISVA policy: Education Committee - Elections 107 (www.cisva.bc.ca/policy_manual)

1.4 Eligible for Nomination: Those eligible to hold office as a member of a parish education committee or to represent the parish on a regional education committee are practicing Catholics, approved by the Pastor, eligible to vote in the parish and have reached the age of twenty-one (21), except for:

- teachers and principal of the parish school
- past employees of the school until three full calendar years have passed since the termination of employment
- employees of the parish and/or school
- spouses, children, parents, brothers and sister of persons covered in the above.

If you would like to run for one of these positions, nomination forms can be picked up either at the school or parish office. The nomination form must be completed in full, signed by Fr. Chisholm and returned to the parish office no later than May 20. Late nomination submissions may not be considered. Elections will be held at all Masses on the weekend of May 27/28.
