PILLARS OF LENT

PRAYER is the action that leads people to God. We take time away from the distractions of the world to turn to God, to contemplate, to listen and talk to Him, to read His words and meditate on them, to be one with Him. Prayer gives meaning to Lenten practices, which should draw us closer to Him.

FASTING is restricting consumption, depriving yourself of both good and bad things for the glory of God. This means normally watching what you eat, on a day that is practiced, one regular meal and two small ones. During Lent, we fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. **ABSTINENCE** is practiced all Fridays of Lent.

ALMSGIVING is the action that leads us Christians to see others, love them, listen to them and give them our time, help, advice, money, shelter, company and affection. It is not limited to giving material goods it is the gift of self. It is based on Charity, to love God and others as oneself. To give alms is to be united to Christ in his poverty.
